







The state-of-the-art cardiac catheterisation laboratories enable precise diagnosis and advanced interventional procedures for cardiac conditions. Additionally, we have a specialised unit with 29 beds exclusively designed for bone marrow transplants, offering advanced treatment options to patients with haematological disorders.

Fifty-one beds dedicated to dialysis services provide optimal care for individuals with renal conditions. Our advanced diagnostic and therapeutic radiology units employ cutting-edge technology to facilitate accurate diagnoses and effective treatment planning. Serving as hubs of innovation and research, the laboratories foster breakthroughs in medical science, enhancing patient care.







The 12th Annual Research Day, held on October 6th and 7th 2022, featured research activities from various disciplines. This year, the special focus was on basic science, medical science, and surgical research as a separate category. The event included 224 poster presentations and 245 podium presentations, spanning two days.

Mission Network

CMC Vellore's extensive network of 170 mission hospitals, operated by Indian Church Missions, brings vital healthcare services to rural areas and marginalised communities, serving as a lifeline for those in need.

The Missions Department focuses on two main aspects: developing individuals with a mission focus and fostering collaboration with mission hospitals. The office, which operates out of CMC Vellore, works to support mission work in various ways.

As part of its mission engagements, in 2017, CMC assumed management of the Kotagiri Medical Fellowship (KMF) Hospital in the Nilgiris to revive the hospital's operations. KMF Hospital was established in 1941 by Pauline Jeffrey, Monica Sutton and Vera Nowell. They converted an abandoned cowshed into a dispensary which, over the years, grew into a hospital known for its eye care services. However, due to various challenges, it declined over time.

Since CMC's takeover, the hospital services have been revitalised; in addition to outpatient and surgical services, it now provides round-the-clock care through its ICU and emergency services. The hospital is also engaged in wider community outreach through palliative and rehabilitative services.


Sources of income


Our Mission
